Register for Fall Festival Now - Rates Go Up After Friday, October 15

Fall Festival Will be November 12-13th in Flat Rock/Hendersonville, NC

Get your convention registration before rates increase from \$65 to \$85 after this Friday, October 15th.

The contests will be held at the Blue Ridge Conference Hall, located at 49 E. Campus Drive in Flat Rock, NC. This is on the campus of Blue Ridge Community College. Quartet semi-finals will be on Friday evening. Saturday will feature the chorus contest and quartet finals.

The headquarters hotel will be the Cascades Mountain Resort, located at 102 Sugarloaf Road in Hendersonville (about a 4 mile drive).

As a reminder, District and facilities policies regarding COVID safety protocols

are that masks are required in all public spaces, including on stage while performing.

Is Your Chorus Smaller Than 12? Compete as a Very Large Quartet!

Has your chorus found itself on the verge of not having the required 12 singers to compete in the chorus contest in Hendersonville?

A number of choruses in our district have found themselves in this situation. Therefore we have decided to host a Very Large Quartet (VLQ) contest along with the chorus competition. A VLQ is defined as any ensemble having between 5 and 11 singers, including the director. This means those smaller choruses who may have given up participating this fall now have another opportunity.

VLQs will perform along with the choruses during the chorus contest on Saturday. They will be competing for the District 1st, 2nd and 3rd place VLQ award much like we score the various Plateau awards today. And yes, award plaques and ribbons will be presented.

If you know now that you won't be bringing the minimum 12 singers, please go into Barberscore and change your chorus registration from the chorus contest to the VLQ contest. If you're not sure, please go ahead and register in Barberscore as either Chorus or VLQ, whichever you think is most likely. I will then confirm your entry a week or so before the contest.
