Chapter Update: Charlotte!

Charlotte's Gold Standard Chorus furthered their connection to Charlotte Mecklenburg School's Choral Program today. We have slowly been building our recognition through email and telephone and resulted in a well-received event today.

We were invited to make a presentation to the CMS music educators staff at their all day professional development session.

George Simolin started our presentation with a brief history of the Charlotte Chapter (will be celebrating the 75th anniversary in 2025) and the Barbershop Harmony Society. Gave some facts and figures and explained our reach throughout the world.

Rob Hopkins was introduced and gave a brief tutorial on Barbershop Harmony and spoke of how the elements of good singing cross over to all choral music. He then emphasized the resources that are available from the Charlotte chapter and from BHS. Handouts were provided with the link to the education pages of BHS website.

Rob then introduced Soundtrack Quartet who blew the gathering away with their singing and performance. These 4 young men are wonderful ambassadors of our artform. After doing two songs they proceeded to teach the teachers a tag. After the entire group sang the tag, they were asked for volunteers to come up and sing the tag. There was no shortage of volunteers, and I got the feeling that this was the best part of their day.

I wrapped it up with mentioning the next two free events that Gold Standard will be doing and extended an invitation to the educators. A brief Q&A concluded our presentation.
