Carolinas District quartet Forecast organized and hosted their first annual A Cappella Spring Sing at Salem Academy, the high school for girls in Winston-Salem. This event was open to all high school singers and drew over 60 girls and boys from North Carolina, South Carolina, and Alabama for a oneday barbershop music workshop and showcase performance on March 29. Three custom arrangements of popular songs for young singers were created by Forecast baritone **Travis Murray** and paired with learning tracks by Forecast tenor Mike Fitch, who directed the men's, women's, and mixed ensembles. Forecast lead and bass Tyler Rackly and Kevin Jones joined the event to round out the teaching team with help from experienced vocalist Mira Fitch, Greensboro BHS chapter director Detra Davis, NSC Board Member Justin Slack, and Charlotte Christian School director Eric Simpson. The Carolinas District provided financial support for the event along with generous donations from Heart of Carolina A Cappella, Triad Harmony Express chorus, Greensboro Tarheel Chorus, and the Williams Center.
