LOCAL RECOGNITION AWARD!

Local Barbershop Singer Achieves Extaordinary Milestone!

Bob "Squeak" Tilton recently celebrated 77 years of membership in The Barbershop Harmony Society (BHS). He is now the longest serving member of BHS who is still actively singing in both a chapter chorus and registered quartet. BHS is an International organization with approximately 14,000 members. Barbershop singing is non accompanied, four-part harmony style singing. Squeak was recognized in early April in front of an auditorium full of his peers at the Carolinas District Convention held at the BPAC at Sandhills Community College. The convention was hosted by the Pinehurst Chapter of BHS – The Golf Capital Chorus – of which Squeak is a former President and current Board Member. The recognition at the convention was fitting as Squeak was one of the creators of the Carolinas District. He also served as its first President in 2010. He was later inducted into the District Hall of Fame.

Honoring his unique position in the society, Squeak was presented with a framed letter from Steve Denino, the Executive Director and Acting CEO of BHS. In his message Steve noted the achievement as "nothing short of remarkable and we are deeply grateful for your steadfast commitment to

barbershop harmony "and that "you have embodied the very best of what it means to be a barbershopper". Reference was also made to Squeak witnessing the evolution of the society and his playing an active role in shaping its legacy.

Speaking of evolution, it all started for Squeak when he and some friends were singing in a men's chorus in the late 1940's. At the suggestion of the father of one of Squeak's friends, a few of the guys in the chorus visited a local barbershop chorus meeting. They loved it, being especially intrigued by the way the harmony, when sung correctly, "rings", something that doesn't happen in traditional choruses or quartets. They joined the BHS that night. Their original quartet name was "The Six Foot Four", a reference to each member being at least 6 foot tall. When their lead moved away, the legendary Buzz Haeger joined the quartet. As Buzz was only 5'11" tall they changed their quartet name and became "The Four Tissimos"! The Squeak nickname started when he had sung the tenor (high) part but shortly after Buzz joined the quartet, he took the tenor role and Squeak moved over to be the Lead. But the nickname lives on till this day.

Three notable events happened for Squeak in the 1950's. The first being when heand a group of fellow barbershoppers were singing in the InternationalConvention headquarters hotel in Washington DC in 1954 and in walked PresidentEisenhower and his entourage. Ike asked them to keep singing and he and hisgroup stayed and listened. Wow, how many of us have ever gotten to perform infront of a President of the United States! Later that year The Four Tissimos won their first ever Illinois District Quartet contest and in 1955 they would go on to win Third Place Medalist honors in the International Quartet contest!

Later on, Squeak was a member of a different quartet that would win the Illinois District contest in 1961 and a chorus that won the Dixie District contest in 2006. The two wins being over 40 years apart!

When asked what he enjoys about singing barbershop and why men in the Pinehurst area should consider joining The Golf Capital Chorus, Squeak cited the joy of singing four- part harmony, the camaraderie of a great group of guys and the charitable efforts the chorus is involved in.

DENVER - More Volunteers Needed!

Hello Fellow Singers (and your friends and family members)
We are so looking forward to our upcoming BHS International Contest the week of **June 30-July 5th**, where over 5,000 people will descend into Denver to SING! We've had a wonderful response from our volunteers but need a few more in the shifts mentioned below.

All volunteers will receive training/info before their duty begins AND a **free** beautiful purple golf shirt to be picked up in room #701 at the convention center. *Volunteers do NOT need to purchase a registration ticket. Taking light rail downtown is VERY convenient.

Here's some places we still need help:

- **Registration Table:** Greet People and give them their name tag and direct them anywhere using the map!
- Barbertots Room: Greet parents and welcome them and their kiddos into the room where the kids can play and grown-ups can watch the live stream contest! *Parents must stay with their own children the whole time (legally).
- Riser Set up team: Help set-up or take-down risers in the auditorium, ballroom, ready-room (3 diff areas, you choose where you'd like).
- **Chorus Host:** Guide a select chorus from their hotel (or the ready-room), through the lobby, and to backstage.
- **Harmony Marketplace:** Help set-up or take-down booths at the market place located in the upper D level at the Convention Center.
- House Team door monitors and badge checkers: Check people's badges as they come in and close the doors before performers begin.
 *most will get to watch the contest during these shifts!
- **Volunteer Table:** Hand out volunteer T-shirts to all Volunteers or sign people up for more shifts (lap-top provided)
